Introduction: Why the specific national requirements important?

- Entities established in Georgia under Georgian legislation must follow Georgian laws
- Requirements imposed by the Grant Contract vs. Requirements set by the national laws

- Project start-up:
 - Project registration with the Revenue Service, Ministry of Finance
 - Opening a bank account for the grant
 - Setting up a team: contracts with staff employed in the project
- Taxation, especially VAT
- Business trips
- Public procurement
